



Coast 2 Coast After School Coaches FAQs

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1. Employment Package

Q. What "Employment Package" do I receive from C2C?

A. You will receive: 1) \$25 per session (sessions vary in length from 1hr to 1.5 hrs); and 2) A Coaching uniform that includes a C2C polo and a pair of shorts.

Q. How and when do I get paid?

A. You will receive your wage either through direct debit into your Bank of America account or by mailing a check to you. Payments are made on the Friday of every second week.

Q. What equipment do I receive?

A. C2C will provide you with: ballsx20; bibsx10, coaching bag; disc-conesx30 and witch-hat conesx8.

2. Job Overview

Q. What exactly will my job entail?

A. Coast 2 Coast will contract you to work for eight to ten weeks. This is the average duration of an after school program. You will work at one or a variety of Elementary or Middle Schools. Your session will usually start between 14:30-15:30. Sessions will vary from being 1 hour in length to being 2.5 hours in length.



At each session, you will be assigned a group of 20 children that you will coach. You will usually coach that same 20 children at each site for the duration of the program.

Q. What is the age and gender of the children?

A. Male and Female aged 4-14 years old.

Q. How are coaching groups split up?

A. Age.

Q. What age group will I be coaching?

A. Each site has a different age group. Coast 2 Coast will inform you of the ages of children at the site/s at the start of the program. You will usually coach a group that has an age span of no greater than 3 years.

Q. What is the soccer ability of the campers?

A. Beginner to intermediate.

Q. When do I find out which site I will be working in?

A. Coaches will receive this information at the orientation.

3. Coaching Orientation

Q. What does the orientation entail?

A. The orientation will run usually for 4 hours. This orientation will cover five main areas: 1) How to Coach; 2) Teaching Points; 3) How to Coach; 4) Games; and 5) Administration (your schedule and contract). Our Director of Coaching is Robert Mulligan. He has a UEFA "B" badge and currently coaches for a youth soccer club ranked fourth in the nation. Our previous coaches usually say that this orientation went far beyond their expectations. Please wear sports apparel to the orientation. You will not be paid for this orientation.
